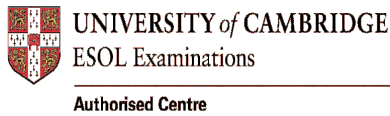

Preparing Students for the Cambridge English: Financial Exam

The *Cambridge English: Financial Exam (ICFE)* is a high-level qualification that will help your students demonstrate that they have the language skills for a successful career in international finance and accountancy. The exam is based on realistic texts, tasks and topics similar to those your students will expect to encounter in their daily working lives as an accounting or finance practitioner. By preparing your students for this exam, you are teaching them the skills they will require to perform well in their professions.

Contents:

We will take a look at the task types in the four parts of the exam: Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking and discuss motivating activities which can be generated from these tasks for classroom use. In addition, deeper insight into the rationale and the assessment criteria of the exam will be provided to help teachers prepare candidates more effectively.

Targets:

- to demonstrate methods which will enable your students to deal confidently with finance-related texts
- to familiarise teachers with the concept and rationale behind the exam
- to discuss exam tips and assessment criteria
- to explore how students may be guided towards improved performance
